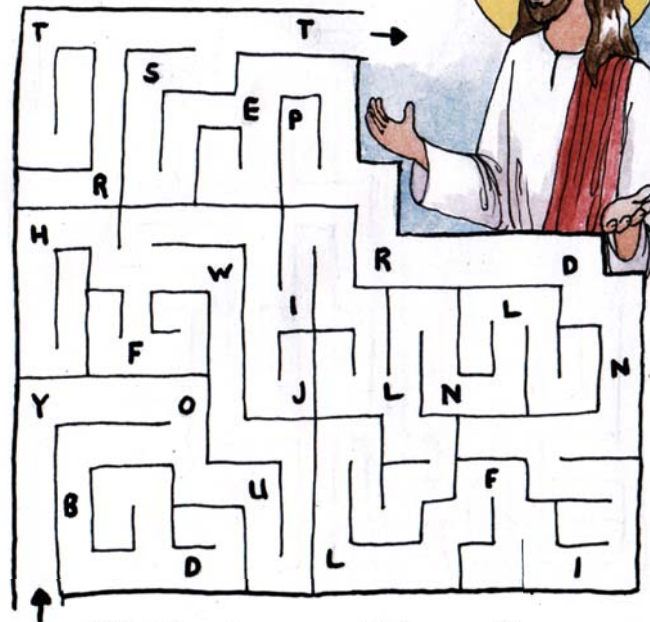

Saint Henry

Holy Roman Emperor
July 13
