Family Connection

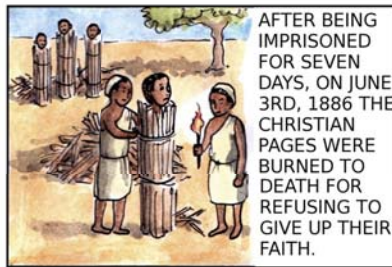
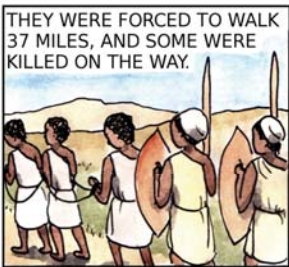
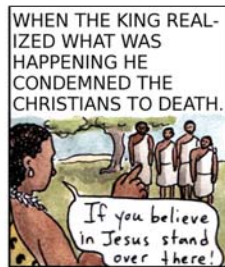
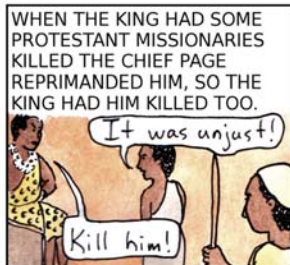
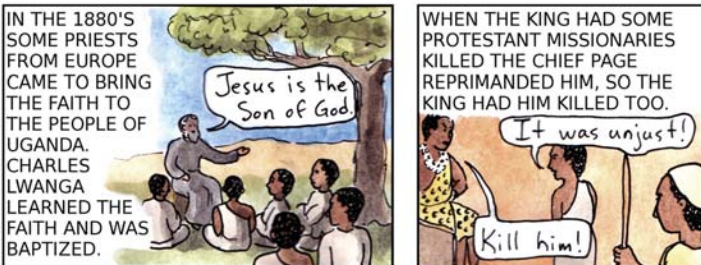
